RE-REGISTRATION

Dear Ben Porat Yosef Family:

We look forward to another wonderful year with you and your family. Here is a brief explanation of the re-registration process and related dates for this season.

Re-registration of Students Currently Enrolled

Enclosed is a Re-registration form, to be completed, signed and submitted by **December 1, 2009**.

Kindly return the items listed below with your completed form.

- \$1,250.00 check made payable to Ben Porat Yosef as a non-refundable application fee **(\$750.00, if submitted by 12/1/09; \$1,000.00, if submitted by 2/1/10)**
- NJ B6T Transportation Form for students entering Kindergarten and up
 - 1 copy of your child's birth certificate for students entering Kindergarten to be submitted with the NJ B6T

Review

A committee will meet to review each new student/sibling application. Priority will be given to returning students whose applications are submitted by 12/1/09, and to siblings of returning students whose applications are submitted by 12/10/09. **Please be aware that your child's registration secures a spot in the school, and is an indication of the number of spots available for children from new families. To ensure your child's spot it is imperative that we receive the re-registration form with payment by December 1, 2009. In addition, please contact Freda Bak at 201-845-5007, x12, if you need to arrange a payment plan for re-registration or sibling application.**

Tuition

- Tuition for grades pre-k and up for the 2010-2011/5771 academic year will be set in the spring by our Board of Directors.
- Tuition contracts, schedule of fees and more information will be mailed in the spring with the first non-refundable tuition payment in the amount of \$1,000.00 due three weeks after receipt.
- Tuition for Toddler and Nursery has been finalized. Please see enclosed tuition schedule.

Tuition Assistance

A family's ability to pay tuition is not a factor in the admissions decision. The Tuition Assistance Committee reviews all applications, and all requests will be kept strictly confidential.

- Tuition Assistance is only available for enrolled families with children in **Pre-Kindergarten or above**.
- Applications are available by mailing in the enclosed card. Due to limited funds, we encourage you to submit your forms complete and on time.
- Tuition Assistance applications are due April 16, 2010.
- Notifications of status or awards will be sent by April 30, 2010.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION

It is the obligation of the parent or guardian of private school students to:

Annually obtain the application for private school transportation from the administrative office of the private school for each student for which transportation services are being requested. Submit a separate application for each student.

If there is a change of home address or the school of attendance, a new application shall be submitted to the private school in which a copy will be forwarded to the public school district of residence.

Complete this application and return it to the private school on or before March 10th preceding the school year in which transportation is being requested.

Late applications-any received after March 10th will be a late application and must be accompanied by a statement of the reason for lateness. Eligible students will receive transportation or aid in lieu of transportation based on the date the application is received by the public school district.

It is the obligation of the nonpublic school administrator to annually collect the applications and submit it to the public school from which transportation is being requested prior to March 15th.

A DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL PAY AID IN LIEU OF TRANSPORTATION TO THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF AN ELIGIBLE STUDENT ONLY AFTER RECEIVING A SIGNED "REQUEST FOR PAYMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AID" VOUCHER AS PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION.
