Course Descriptions:

Active Zone: (N-K): Energy, energy, energy! Coach Doug Haan will be helping the children release all that energy with fun and exciting activity, games and sports!

Art Fun: (N): Morah Nikki Sausen will introduce the children to many different variations of art! They will do anything from painting, molding clay, designing and more! Get ready for some fun, exciting and new arts and crafts!

Art Techniques: Collage (1-4): The children will be working on artistic collage projects which may include newspaper clippings, ribbons, bits of colored or hand-made papers, portions of other artwork, and photographs glued to paper, canvas, or wood.

Aviation Club (K-1): Let's take off! Build at least two model airplanes from scratch! Learn to read model plans, work with metric rulers, make necessary calculations and distinguish between different hobby tools. This high-flying course takes your child outside to see their gliders in motion and fly their own models! In addition, students will learn about the history, aerodynamics, physics and properties of flight and even conduct weather experiments.

Choir (1-4): The school choir, led by Rav Shachar Shalom will meet weekly to learn new Hebrew songs and perform in various school and after school activities (such as the Chanuka Chagiga and more).

Fun in Hebrew (N-K): Led by Morah Elisheva and Morah Tiferet, our *Bnot Sherut* the children will enjoy games, stories, songs and many more activities ...all in Hebrew of course!

Judaic Art (Pre K – K): Led by Morah Nikki Sausen the children will be creating Jewish items with their artistic and creative hands. Some items include *mezuzot*, wine bottle holders for *Shabbat*, a "Modeh Ani" plaque and more!

Kindermotion (N): Led by Miss Myrna the children will be introduced to Kindermotion which is a developmentally designed educational program. Through creative imagery, motor skills, physical development, fitness, and nutrition it will prepares the children's' minds and bodies for athletic and academic pursuits.

Kinderdance (Pre K – K): Miss Myrna's Kinderdance program is geared towards children of all ages. It will teach the children to blend the physical skills of creative movement, acrobatics, fitness, and dance while stressing the development of gross motor, social and language skills, imagination, creativity, self- esteem and confidence.

Mini Mishmar (2-4): Rabbi Ronen will engage the children in extra Torah study each week. Learning will include *Mishna* and *Pizmonim*. Rabbi Ronen's dynamic and exciting way makes Torah study come alive for children!

Music (Pre K - K): "Music Together" will lead a class of an artistically conceived flow of songs, instrumental jam sessions, finger plays, and movement activities. The combination and types of activities are research-based and support children's developing competence in tonality and rhythm. In addition, activities evolve from the child's world and include vocal play, animal sounds, rhythm play, language play, and a good bit of genuine fun.

Nature (Pre-K - K): The Tenafly Nature Center will lead the children through an exploration of the natural world. Through games, hands on activities, and live animals your children will gain an appreciation and respect for the natural world around them.
